- Provide a curriculum that meets your child's well-being, mental health and academic needs.
- Continue our clear and consistent approach to rewards and sanctions for children as set out in our existing Positive Behaviour and Discipline Policy as well as the temporary changes and additions to our policy and the expectations outlined in this agreement.
- Communicate between home and school through notices, newsletters, text, email and the school website.

Parent/Carer.....

To help my child at school, I know and understand that:

- If my child, or anyone in my household, shows symptoms of COVID-19, I will not send them to school, we will follow latest government guidance on self-isolation as a family, I will get them tested and I will let the school know the result as soon as possible by telephone.
- If a child shows symptoms of Covid-19, all other members of their bubble may be sent home and asked to self-isolate (dependent on their level of contact with the ill child) until the result of the initial child's test is known. If the test is negative, children can return to school.
- When dropping my child off and picking them up, I will adhere to the 2 metre social distancing rules, observing the routes marked out around the school site. I need to leave the premises swiftly to avoid any congestion and allow other parents to access school.
- When dropping off and picking up, I will strictly adhere to the school timings for my child.
- My child will bring minimal items into school: their coat, a small backpack/bag, reading book(s), book bag, water bottle and packed lunch (in a washable container). My child must be able to open/handle their lunch box items independently, e.g. opening yogurt tubes, peeling fruit. Water bottles will be sent home to be washed daily.
- I need to ensure my child can do their own laces, coat zip, etc. independently.
- I will ensure my child wears PE kit to school on allocated days.
- I will remind my child often about social distancing rules but accept they are difficult to follow and that my child may not always do this successfully.
- I will remind my child often to use good respiratory and hand hygiene.
- I will not be allowed into the school building unless extremely urgent and not without a pre-arranged appointment; I will make appointments via telephone or email.
- I need to support all staff in their efforts to create an 'as safe as possible' environment during this crisis.
- I need to read all letters/messages/emails that are sent home.
- I need to inform the school immediately of any changes to parent/carers and emergency contacts details.
- I understand that if my child's behaviour in school is deemed unsafe, he/she will be sent home and cannot return to school until they can be safe.
- I will avoid term-time holidays to ensure my child has full access to the curriculum. When planning out of term-time holidays, I will avoid places where quarantining upon return may be necessary so that my child's school learning time is not lost.
