### **POLICY FOR WEARING OF JEWELLERY**

Jewellery is not allowed in school. No jewellery of any kind should be worn.

A watch with a plain simple strap is allowed. If children wear a watch then it is their responsibility to look after it. Toy watches should not be worn.

Children should always have their ears pierced at the very beginning of the summer holidays so that sleepers/studs can be removed in the autumn term.

If sleepers/studs have to be worn because ears have been recently pierced and not healed, then they must be removed by either the child or parent before each PE or physically active lesson. It is no longer acceptable to cover ear-rings with tape. If children are unable to remove their own sleepers/studs they will be unable to take part in physical activities; for Nursery and Reception children this will include all outdoor play sessions which are on a daily basis.

As staff are responsible for physical activities it is not possible to issue a disclaimer for parents to sign. However, neither is it reasonable to expect staff to always remember to remind children not to wear ear-rings and jewellery.
