SAFEGUARDING STATEMENT

All the governors and staff at Heron Hill Primary School share an objective to help keep the children safe by:

- Providing a safe environment for them in which they can learn.
- Identifying children who are suffering, likely to suffer harm or at risk of radicalisation.
- Taking appropriate action with the aim of making sure that they are kept safe both at home and in the education setting.

To achieve this objective, we:

- Take active measures to prevent unsuitable people from working with the children
- Promote safe practice and challenge any poor or unsafe practice.
- Identify instances where there are grounds for concern about a child's welfare and initiate or take appropriate action to keep them safe.
- Contribute to effective partnership working between all those involved in providing services for our children.
- Provide training at an appropriate level for all Staff, Governors and Volunteers in Safeguarding, Safer recruitment, Understanding of the pathways to Extremism and the Prevent programme, Safer Handling of Children and other training where appropriate.
